


University Hill






Mapleton Hill

Mapleton Hill is a designated historic district with streets lined with Silver Maple trees, heritage homes and new construction. In addition to single family houses, Mapleton Hill also has attached dwellings such as townhomes and condominium developments that have been converted from estate homes. Newlands






Wonderland Hills



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
